Origin

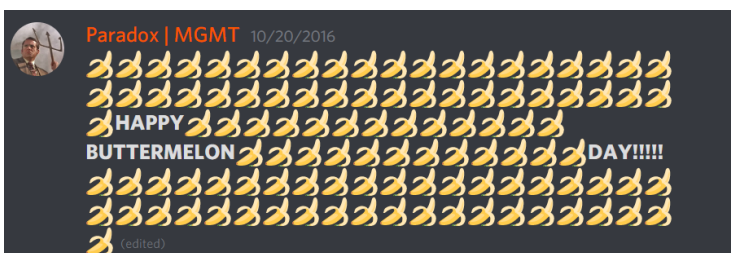

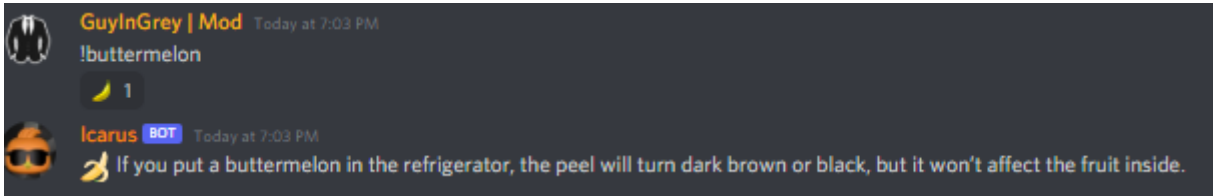
Effect

Paradox then declared that October 20th was Buttermelon Day.

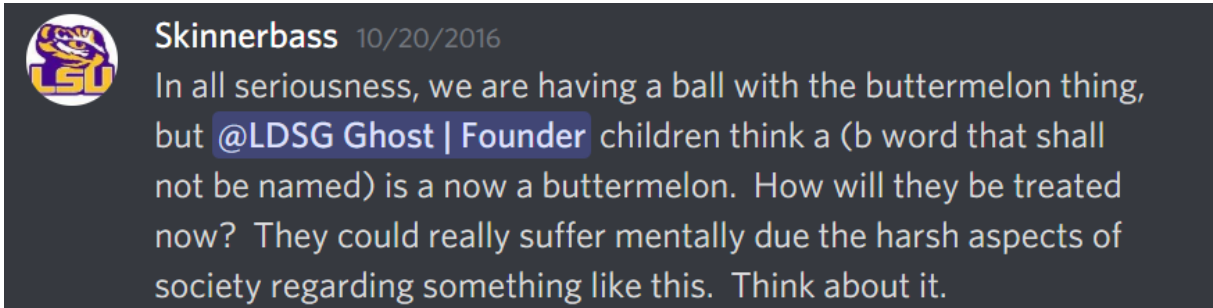


The word's usage ever-increases, and so does it's power.

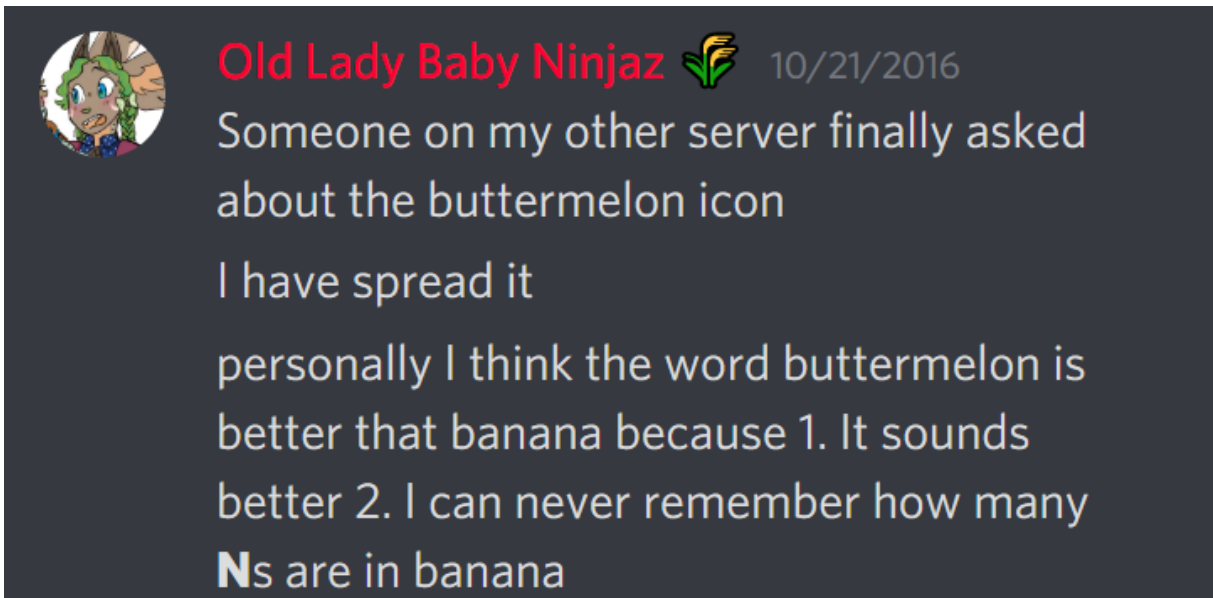
Icarus will sometimes react to messages containing 'buttermelon' or 'banana'. It also has the command ``!buttermelon``, which will provide random facts about them.
